- ▶ Registration / Qualification – minimal HSE Offshore Medic*, HCPC / HCPCSA Registered Paramedic, NAREMT or RCN Registered Nurse.
- ▶ *If you hold the HSE Offshore Medic qualification you must also be able to prove that you have served as a CMT1, LMA or Class 1 Medic RAF.
- ▶ Close Protection qualification from an accredited provider (BTEC Level III and above).
- ▶ SIA licence
- ▶ Pre-Hospital Trauma Life Support (PHTLS) or equivalent.
- ▶ Support (ATLS) training and certification may be required.
